NEW BOAT JOINS PORTSMOUTH'S ICON FLEET

TCC officials announced the newest addition to Portsmouth's growing fleet of sailboat icons during the ground-breaking ceremony for the new Victory Village campus on Friday, May 16. The blank model will be painted by TCC graphic arts students.

The sailboat icons are elegant tributes to Portsmouth's proud maritime heritage. Measuring 45" long by 60" high, they provide ample area for colorful, creative artwork.

A portion of each boat's \$2,700 selling price is donated to a worthy organization within the City of Portsmouth. Contributions thus far have been made to the **Elizabeth River Project**, **Starbase Atlantis**, the **Children's Museum** expansion and the **Friends of the Portsmouth Library**.

Boats have been delivered to **Mayor Holley**, **W F Magann Corp**, the **Portsmouth Partnership** and **TCC**. Orders have been placed by **Associated Contracting Services**, **Bon Secours**, **Tri-City Developers, LLC**, **Lindab**, and **Western Branch Diesel**. An additional boat, ordered by **Sales Systems, Ltd.**, will be donated & placed in the new **Churchland Branch Library**.
